2017 JFCA BEEF SHOW

General Guidelines for the Beef Show are as follows -

Showmanship-

- Divisions will be determined by age as of July 27th, 2017. Juniors (8-11), Intermediate (12-14), Senior (15 18 not graduated high school), and Collegiate (18-21 graduated high school).
- There will be two rings running simultaneously for showmanship.
- Exhibitor is responsible for being ringside and ready to enter ring when called. No late entry to the ring will be allowed.

Bred and Owned Steers/Heifers:

 Exhibitor must mark that calf is Bred and Owned on entry form. Must be Breeder, 1st, and continuous owner!

Steers

- Will be shown by weight and classification.
- Steers will be classified by committee at the scales.

Bulls

- Must be 24 months or younger, as of July 27th.
- Will be shown by weight.
- Must have a nose ring to show.

Heifers

- Must be 36 months or younger.
- Will be shown by weight.
 - NOTE Exhibitor is responsible for being ringside and ready to enter the ring, with their animal, when called by lineup coordinator. No late entry to the ring will be allowed once the class begins.
 NO EXCEPTIONS! The Show Committee will make every effort to call/notify exhibitors where we are in the show though a speaker system, however it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to keep up with the speed of classes and show order.
 - Exhibitor MUST use the animals they entered for showmanship.
 - Exhibitor MUST show their animal in class to be awarded any points.

2017 JFCA Beef Show Important Information

- NO MANURE IN GARBAGE CANS! Please use specified areas ONLY!!
- NO ANIMALS ALLOWED IN RV AREA! If animals are found in RV Area at any time you will be asked to
 leave the premises and your cattle will be disqualified from the show. No refund will be given and NO
 EXCEPTIONS to this rule will be permitted! Animals should only be in designated areas. If you have a
 question about this, please speak to a member of the Show Committee.
- Shavings will be provided in the barns. Extra bulk shavings will be available on-site.
- Extra power has been added to the barns; however generators are encouraged and suggested.
- NO GENERATORS are allowed in the barns. Generators must be kept outside.
- Fans are only allowed on L brackets or on stall dividers. No butt fans will be allowed in aisle ways, due to space.
- To assist in creating a cooler environment, please plan on setting up all fans facing the North.
- All chutes are to be placed in the overhang area on the south side of the barn or on the dirt in the north barn.
- Steer breeds will be determined at the scales during weigh-in, between 12 2 on Thursday.
- All animals will be weighed. Registered animals will be shown by age. Non registered animals will be shown by weight.
- Bull must have nose ring and lead.
- Commercial bulls do not need to be registered. Brahman Bulls do need to be registered.
- Please remember to mail registration papers in with entries. Registration papers will be checked at check in.
- **You MUST use an animal that you entered in the show during showmanship or you will receive no points. This will be strongly enforced at all shows!** Collegiate Showmanship Exhibitors can borrow animals for showmanship if they do not have any animals entered into the show.
- **You must exhibit the animals that you have entered in the show in order to receive points for the
 class placing and overall points (if awarded). No exceptions. This will be strongly enforced at all
 shows. If you have more than one animal in a class, division or drive, assistance is acceptable.
- Please clean beds of hay, feed, straw, etc before leaving the fairgrounds, at the conclusion of the show.
- Please help us by cleaning up after yourself & others in the barn, tie-out area, trailer parking areas,
 etc. There will be garbage cans and manure bins scattered for your convenience.
