Individual registrations (Full & Badge Only), and a la carte meal tickets will be sold on site while tickets last. The most affordable way to attend conventon and only way to guarentee your meal tickets is to pre-register.

INDIVIDUAL PRE-REGISTRATION

Once again, Individual adult and youth (ages 3-12) registrations will be available at Full and Badge-Only levels. The Badge-Only registration includes access to everything but the three ticketed banquet style meals. Full registrations include a badge and tickets to the Youth Luncheon, Cattlemen's Supper, and Cattlemen's Banquet. Children under 3 years old not occupying a chair or being served a meal do not need to be registered. Ask us for a complimentary youth badge for children under 3.

RESERVED TABLE REGISTRATION

Due to many complaints in recent years regarding the on-site reserved table process, the FCA Executive Committee reviewed the issue during its September meeting and finalized a new plan shortly thereafter. To reduce the Association's financial risk and improve the fairness and efficiency of reservations, reserved tables will now be tied directly to full registrations. Guests may still enjoy open seating by completing standard registration, but those wishing to reserve tables will do so in advance through the registration process.

A half table (five seats) may be reserved for \$2,500 and includes five full registrations. You may reserve up to two half tables per member, creating a full table of ten seats/full registrations, for a total of \$5,000. It is preffered that you list all guest names at the time of registration, any "to be determined" guests must be confirmed by April 15, 2026.

Please follow the instructions on the Table Reservation/Registration page to complete your purchase. All reserved table placements within the event space will be determined and assigned at a later date, once registration is complete.

This is the first year of implementing this new process, and we appreciate everyone's patience and cooperation as we work to make it as smooth and fair as possible. The goal is to alleviate the past complaints and challenges while creating a more consistent and transparent system for years to come. Even if adjustments are needed moving forward, the Association is committed to refining and maintaining this improved process long term.

This new approach ensures all meal tickets are covered, simplifies check-in, and creates a smoother, more organized experience for everyone involved.

RETURNING SPONSORS

Returning 2025 sponsors have the right of first refusal to secure the same sponsorship in 2026. This right is to be exercised on or before February 15th, 2026. All sponsorships must be confirmed by May 15th, 2026.

SHARES


