

CARLTON D MCKETTRICK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Carlton D. McKettrick Memorial Scholarship for college upperclassmen and graduates students studying agriculture has been established by the McKettrick family, the Florida Cattlemen's Association and the Florida Cattlemen's Foundation.

Carlton Dewitt "Carl" McKettrick was serving as the Florida Association of Livestock Markets Representative on the Florida Cattlemen's Association Executive Board when he passed away suddenly in May 2015. He served many years as a volunteer leader in the industry he loved being both the President of FALM and the Desoto County Cattlemen's Association.

For several years Carl dreamed of building a new state -of- the-art livestock market. The Arcadia Stockyard, completed in 2005 stands as the realization of that dream. Since its opening Carl has graciously hosted numerous cattle industry activities, eager to share his passion for the cattle industry. He was especially generous to youth groups with the goal of nurturing their interest in the cattle business.

PURPOSE:

Established in 2015, and initially awarded in 2016, to provide funds for educational assistance at the Junior/Senior or graduate college level for qualified students to pursue an agricultural degree.

ADMINISTRATION:

The Florida Cattlemen's Foundation – Scholarship Committee

VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Two awards in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded. This will be awarded at the annual FCA Annual Convention. The recipient(s) will be notified no later than May 15 of each year to allow for the opportunity to attend the awards ceremony at the convention, which is usually held during the month of June. Financial award maybe used for Tuition & Fees only. Award will be distributed in one single Semester and will be payable to the institution at which the student is enrolled in.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. The applicant or applicants parent/guardian must be a Florida Cattlemen's Association member in good standing for at least six months prior to submitting this scholarship application (October 1 of year prior to applying in April).
- 2. Applicant must have completed a minimum of 60 credit hours, so that the student will be entering at least the junior year or post graduate courses during the year the scholarship is awarded.
- 3. Applicant must have an Agricultural related major of study.
- 4. Applicant must be attending a Florida college/university **OR** a Florida resident attending an out of state college/university.
- 5. Applicant must show a minimum of a 2.0 GPA.

APPLICATION:

- 2. One (1) letter of recommendation.
- 3. Most up-to-date transcript available at time of submission.
- 4. Typed 300-600 word essay. Prompt:
 How has agriculture affected your life and what aspect will your college plans further your agricultural goals?
