- **All participants MUST BE CURRENT JFCA MEMBERS**

You will be required to list your JFCA # when registering for contests

- There will be a \$30 Registration fee for all participants (Regardless if you are staying onsite or not, attending tours, evening event or meals)
- There will be no charge for guests to watch Contests
- To stay onsite at the Warner University Dorms the cost is \$30 for 1 night/per person and \$55 for 2 nights/per person. You can stay 1 night or both. (This cost is in addition to the \$30 registration fee for participants)
- **Registration fees MUST be paid before any Participant competes**-can pay online, cash onsite or by County Leader-indicate on registration how you prefer to pay
- **Payment for staying in Dorms can be paid online by emailed invoice, cash onsite, or paid by County Leader-indicate on Registration Form how you prefer to pay**
- County Leaders- you can do all the entries for the youth coming from your County- **but it will need to be filled out for each individual attending this year**
